***Jane's Smart Art Guides*** are for travelers who want to know what they're looking at when they're touring one of the many historic sites in Europe that abound with remarkable art.

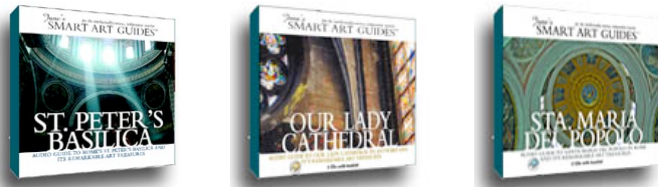

You’ll learn about the artists, their patrons and their subjects. You’ll hear anecdotes about their lives and character, vignettes of history and legend, and the values and customs of the time. Jane offers commentary and perspective on aesthetic and technological developments, stylistic variations and influences, composition, materials and technique. Each tour is set in the context of the surrounding city’s long and tumultuous history, to provide a deep and lasting appreciation of the place.
